



## **NEW-INDY CATAWBA'S UPDATED WEBSITE OFFERS NEW, DAILY INFORMATION**

**Catawba, S.C.** - New-Indy Catawba has modified and upgraded its website, [www.newindycatawba.com](http://www.newindycatawba.com), to give more timely information to the public about its operations.

The website has been redesigned to increase the information it provides to communities around the mill. It now offers daily air emissions reports, public announcements, and the latest news about improvements to the facility.

Revised features include an interactive map of daily air monitors overseen by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control and New-Indy itself dating back to May 13, 2021, when monitoring began. The map also displays a daily graphic that measures the health of the mill's retention ponds, a weekly operations report and a new Twitter feed, @NewIndyCatawba.

The site has Frequently Asked Questions about the mill and a Question & Answer section from a toxicologist about hydrogen sulfide. An operational timeline has been deployed on the site, which details mill improvements since February 2021.
